## Background:

Irish Sea sole is subject to ICES zero-catch advice for sole in the Irish Sea (SOL.27.7a) for 2024. The EU and the UK note that the stock will be subject to a benchmark process by ICES in February 2024.

## Description of requested work:

The EU and UK note that the benchmark for Irish Sea sole is taking place from 19-23rd of February 2024. The EU and UK have agreed that upon the completion of this benchmark exercise, to request ICES to publish revised advice based on the outcome of the benchmark as soon as practically possible with a view to amend the fishing opportunities for 2024 in the event that the benchmark leads to a change in the perception of the stock. Consequently, the EU and UK would like to receive revised advice no later than 31 May or earlier if practically possible. This information will be used to amend the fishing opportunities for Irish Sea sole in 2024 if appropriate.
