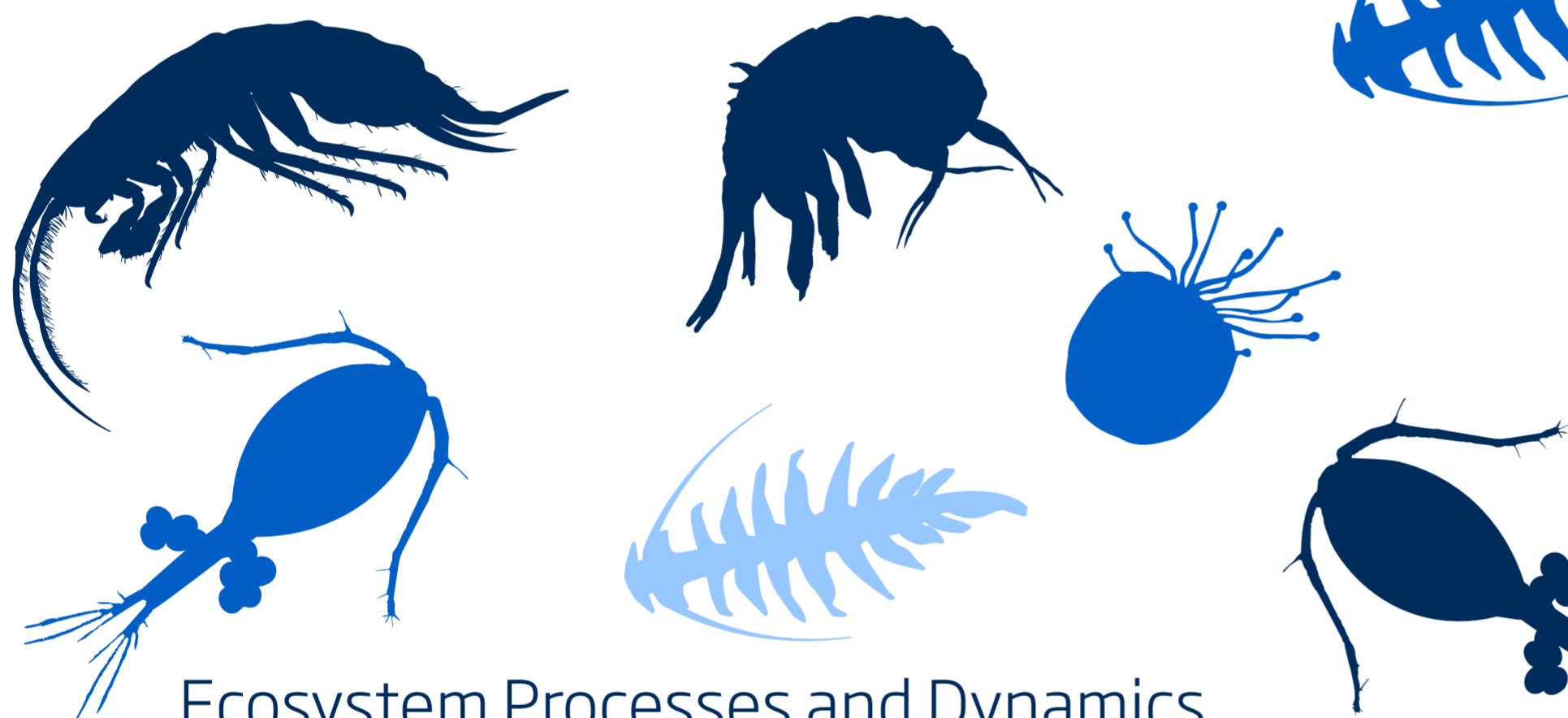

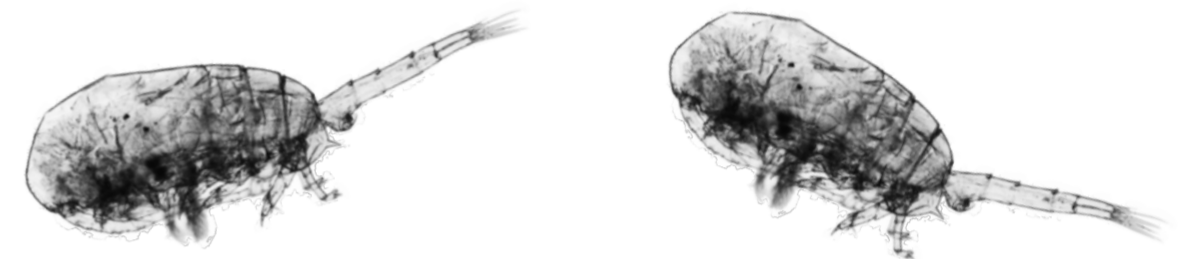

RESEARCH FOCUS

- Geographical distribution, seasonal patterns and interannual variations of *P. marinus* in European waters.
- Identification of key ecological, biological and behavioural traits of *P. marinus*.
- Molecular and morphological identification of *P. marinus*.
- Establish trophic position and interactions of *P. marinus*.

OUR OBJECTIVE

To establish a network of European (and non-European) scientists and institutions working on different aspects related to the biology and ecology of the non-indigenous calanoid copepod *Pseudodiaptomus marinus*. To facilitate knowledge sharing and collaborations among the participants, both through comparative and integrative studies from different lines of research.



OUR EXPERTISE

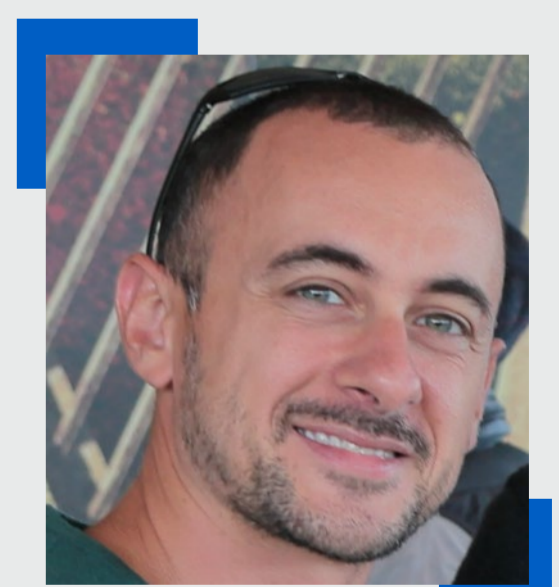
WGEUROBUS includes more than 50 participants from 15 countries. The expertise of the group is varied, thanks to the different know-how and skills of the participants, and include:
